Three of them, Mel Hebert, Howell Todd and Mike Wamble, have already been interviewed. Two of these you already know, but Mike is a member at Maple Hill and has asked to be considered.

We wanted to share with you what is coming up soon and what we will need you to do. Mike will be speaking to us next Sunday so everyone can get to meet him. Mel and Howell have been doing a great job the last few months filling in for us and you have all heard them speak at numerous occasions. We have at least one more applicant to interview. If the men feel he is qualified to be considered, we will have him speak before you as well. We hope you will get to know all the applicants the next few weeks and determine for yourself who you would like to be hired.

Once the applicants have spoken to us the men will pick a Sunday for all of you to vote. This vote will not be the deciding factor but instead will be used by the men to get a feel for who the congregation likes. We will then go over all the applicants and make a decision.

The person we are looking for will help to strengthen the congregation. He will be preaching for us on Sundays as well as help conduct congregational Bible studies when needed. He will play a very important role of helping us to share the gospel to the community around us as well as ministering to those here in this congregation. We are not looking for someone who will do these jobs for us, instead we are looking
