- M ..otivator.** Yes, she “provokes us unto love and good works.” Hebrews 10:24
- O ..pportunist.** She sees her motherhood as an opportunity to mold her children to serve God. Proverbs 22:6
- T ..eacher.** She never fails to instruct in the way of holiness. 1 Corinthians 11:1.
- H ..appy.** She enjoys the challenge of guiding the home. 1 Timothy 5:14.
- E ..xample.** She practices hospitality without grudging. 1 Peter 4:9
- R ..eliable.** You can count on her to constantly seek first the kingdom. Matthew 6:33.

I am so very thankful that each year we can celebrate and honor the life and memories of our mothers.
