God's Plan for Salvation

God has clearly given us a pattern that we should follow that will lead us to Salvation. Let us take a few minutes to look at some scriptures that show us how God planned to save us from our sins.

- <u>Step 1</u> **Hearing** the Word: "So then faith comes by hearing and hearing through the word of Christ" (Romans 10:17)
- <u>Step 2</u> **Believing** Jesus is the Son of God: "Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved" (Mark 16:16)
- <u>Step 3</u> Repent your sins to God: "Repent and be baptized every one of you for the forgiveness of your sins..." (Acts 2:38)
- <u>Step 4</u> Confess that Jesus is the Son of God: "If you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved." (Romans 10:9)
- <u>Step 5</u> **Be Baptized**: "Baptism, which corresponds to this, now saves you, not as a removal of dirt from the body but as an appeal to God for a good conscience." (1 Peter 3:21)
