## The Power of Song

A song will set the emotion, energy, and excitement for any scene in a movie. A song can take you to a special time and place in your past. A song can be used to lift your spirit. A song can bring a tear to your eye. THE POWER OF A SONG!!!

#### Col 3:16-17

16 Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom, teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord.
17 And whatever you do in word of deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through Him.

Have you ever stopped to think about why God chose songs as a way to teach one another? We can easily see the power of song when we look at a 1st grader. We can teach them the alphabet, dates and events, and even how a conjunction works (anybody remember "Conjunction Junction, What's Your Function?"). We can teach in the Sunday school classroom ... The Fruits of the Spirit, The Days of Creation, The Names of the Apostles, and all 66 books of the Bible. What a powerful tool songs can be!!

Songs were also to be used to admonish one another. The Greek word used here as admonish means, "to put in mind, that is (by implication) to caution or reprove gently:" (Strong's Concordance) Songs were to be used to warn and teach of the dangers of forsaking the word of God. What a powerful tool songs can be!!

Paul said to "Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly." By allowing songs to focus our minds on the word of Christ, they can and will bring wisdom. By allowing the word into your heart, the word will allow your way to be clearer. We read in Psalms 119:105 'your word is a lamp to my feet, and a light to my path.' As we sing with grace in our heart to the Lord, let us make every effort to do so in the name of Jesus, giving thanks to God for all things...Especially SONGS!!
