Much of the door knocking will be done in Marshalltown this time and the nightly meeting will be held up there. Keep this effort in your prayers.

Brethren, God is good to us and has blessed our efforts richly. Of course we have to have his blessings to be able to accomplish anything. The challenges are great and at times seem insurmountable, but God always gets us through each one. And so often brings things about in such a way that is a great blessing.
