The Lord's Church

The church does not belong to you or to me; it belongs tot he Lord. After all, He built it (Mt. 16:18), purchased it with His blood (Acts 20:28), is the head of it (Eph. 1:22-23), and is the Savior of it (Eph. 5:23).

The Bible describes the church as His body (Col 1:18, 23) and as His bride (Eph 5:23-31). The church is Christ's kingdom (Mt 16:18-19, Col 1:13-14; Rev 1:4-6).

The Lord adds the saved to His church (Acts 2:41-47). The Lord himself determines whom He will add. Some people speak of "joining the church," but one does not "join the church." The Lord must add one to the church. The Lord adds people to His church when one is saved.

When one out of love responds to the gospel in faith, repentance and baptism, the Lord saves and adds that person to his number (Acts 2:27-47). In God's eyes, the saved and the church are one and the same. If the Lord has saved a person, He has also added him to His church.

In today's world there are many religious groups which teach various plans of salvation that differ greatly from the apostolic teaching found in the New Testament. Some have tampered with God's word by redefining what it means to believe, to repent, and to be baptized. When people replace the Divine teaching with their own human traditions, they build their houses on sand (Mt. 7:24-27) and rely on their own faulty, human judgment (Mt. 15:8-14).

The church in the New Testament was made up on identifiable, local congregations. These congregations were autonomous and led by a

plurality of elders and deacons (Phil 1:1; 1 Tim 3:1-4).

The Lord's church was called to evangelize the world. (Mt 28:18-20), to build itself up in faith and love (Eph 4:11-16), and to do good to all (Gal. 6:9-10). The Lord wanted his church to offer up sacrifices of praise, the fruit of lips that give thanks to His name (Heb 13:15) and to share with those in need (13:16). God wanted His people to abound in the work of the Lord (1 Cor. 15:58).

The Lord expects His people to remain faithful to Him and to the teaching given by the apostles (Acts 2:42; 2 Thess. 2:15). When people vary from the will of God, they lose their relationship with God (2 John 9).

The Lord has adorned His bride, the church, to live with Him in heaven forever and ever (Rev. 21:1-4). The church is God's glorious representative in the world today, practicing His will and doing His work. God is planning and preparing to bless those who are His with great love in heaven (Eph. 2:5-7; Phil. 3:20-21).

Aren't you thankful to be a member of the Lord's church? Don't you wish everyone were?
